Curators Corner

NCHS was awarded CAP (Conservation Assessment Program) Grant with the intent to evaluate the Male Academy’s current collection storage facility and condition of the collection. The current storage for the museum’s collection is not only inconvenient, but not up to conventional museum environmental standards for fire and water protection and we have outgrown the space. We were fortunate to not only receive the services of a conservationist but also an architect. The architect will help provide information for the possibility on constructing a collection storage facility or suggesting an alternative. Both conservationists visited Newnan on July 24th. The visited the Male Academy Museum and the History Center (Depot) as well as the collection storage, currently located in a local bank vault. We should have their report by the end of September. That report will give us recommendations on how to better manage and store our current collection. We are fortunate to have the collection we do thank the contributors of Coweta citizens and we are responsible for maintaining those objects to museum standards for the future citizens of the county. Currently we are not fulfilling that obligation as best we could and we hope with this report in hand we will be able to begin an effort to better that situation.
